## Do You Need A Lawyer?

If you need a lawyer, the NEA provides WEA/NEA members with the services of an attorney at a discounted hourly rate. The Attorney Referral Program (ARP) is a service provided to NEA members (active, life, educational support or retired, their spouses and dependent children) who need services of an attorney on personal legal matters, i.e., not employment-related.

Participating ARP attorneys provide each member with two free 30-minute consultation sessions during each year of the program (Sept. 1 through Aug. 31). These two free consultations are taken separately and deal with two different questions. This benefit allows you to discuss your problem with an attorney to determine whether you need additional legal services.

If your problem falls within any of the areas listed below, the attorney's fees are discounted 30%:

- (1) real estate matters;
- (2) wills and estates;
- (3) domestic relations;
- (4) consumer protection; or
- (5) traffic violations
